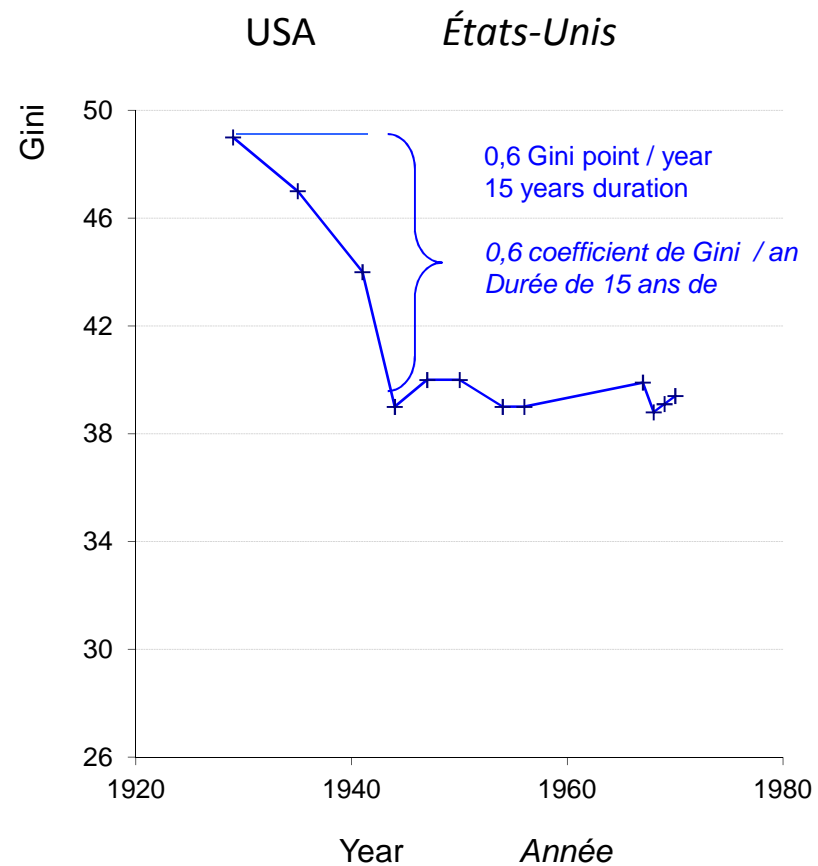

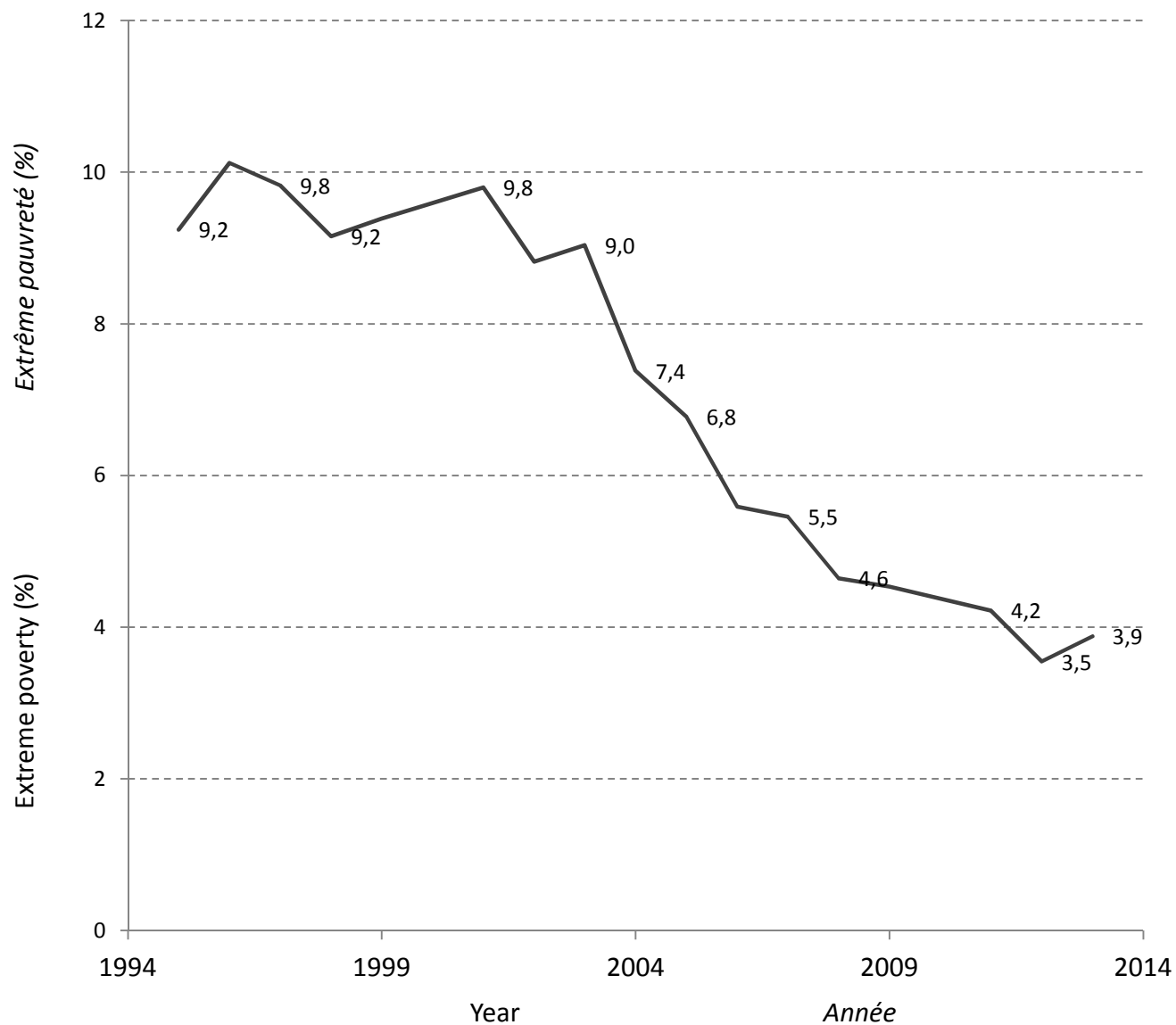




Inequality: Comparison with UK and USA

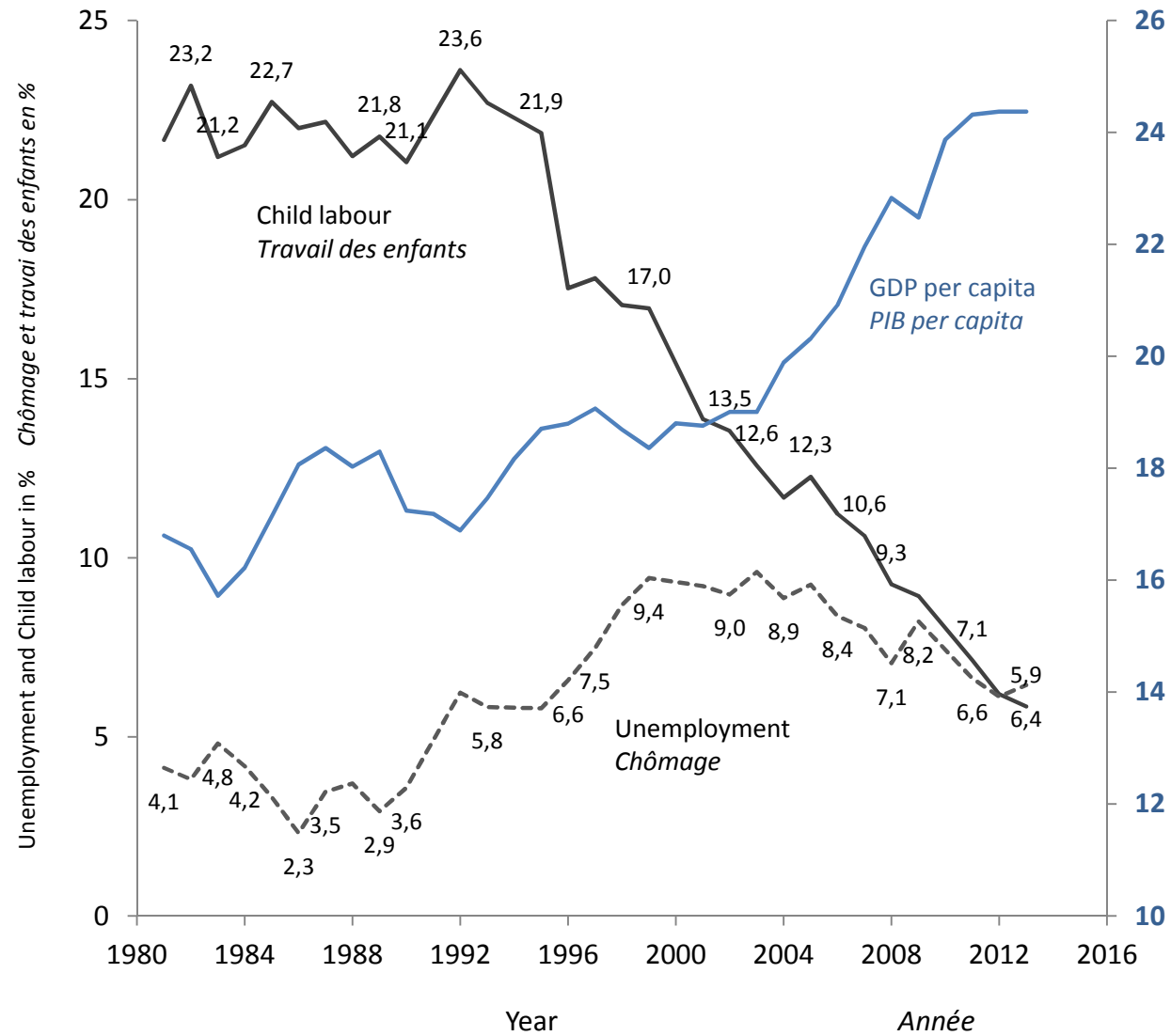
Extreme poverty (close to \$1 /day PPP)

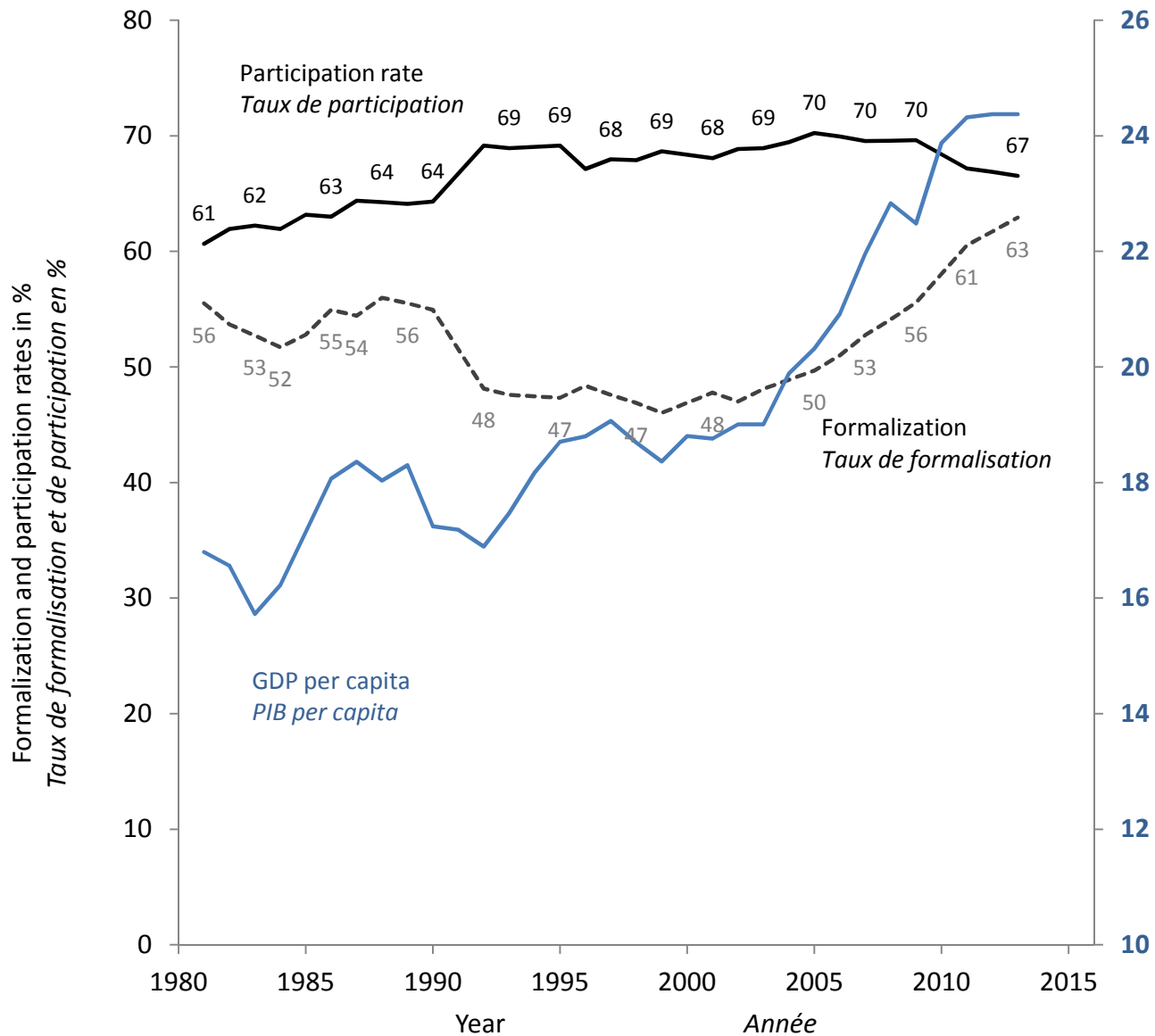
Poverty (close to \$2 /day PPP)

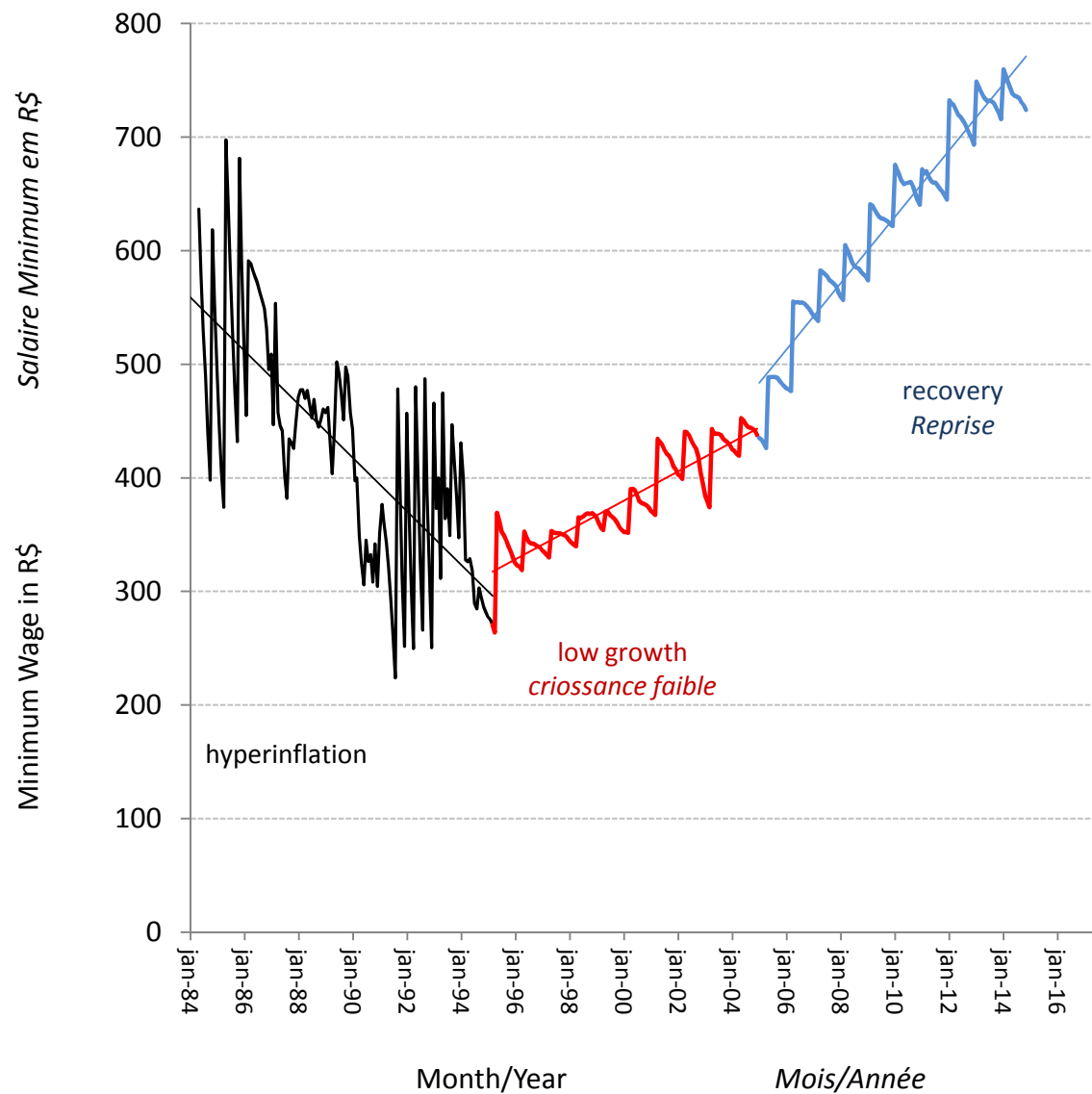

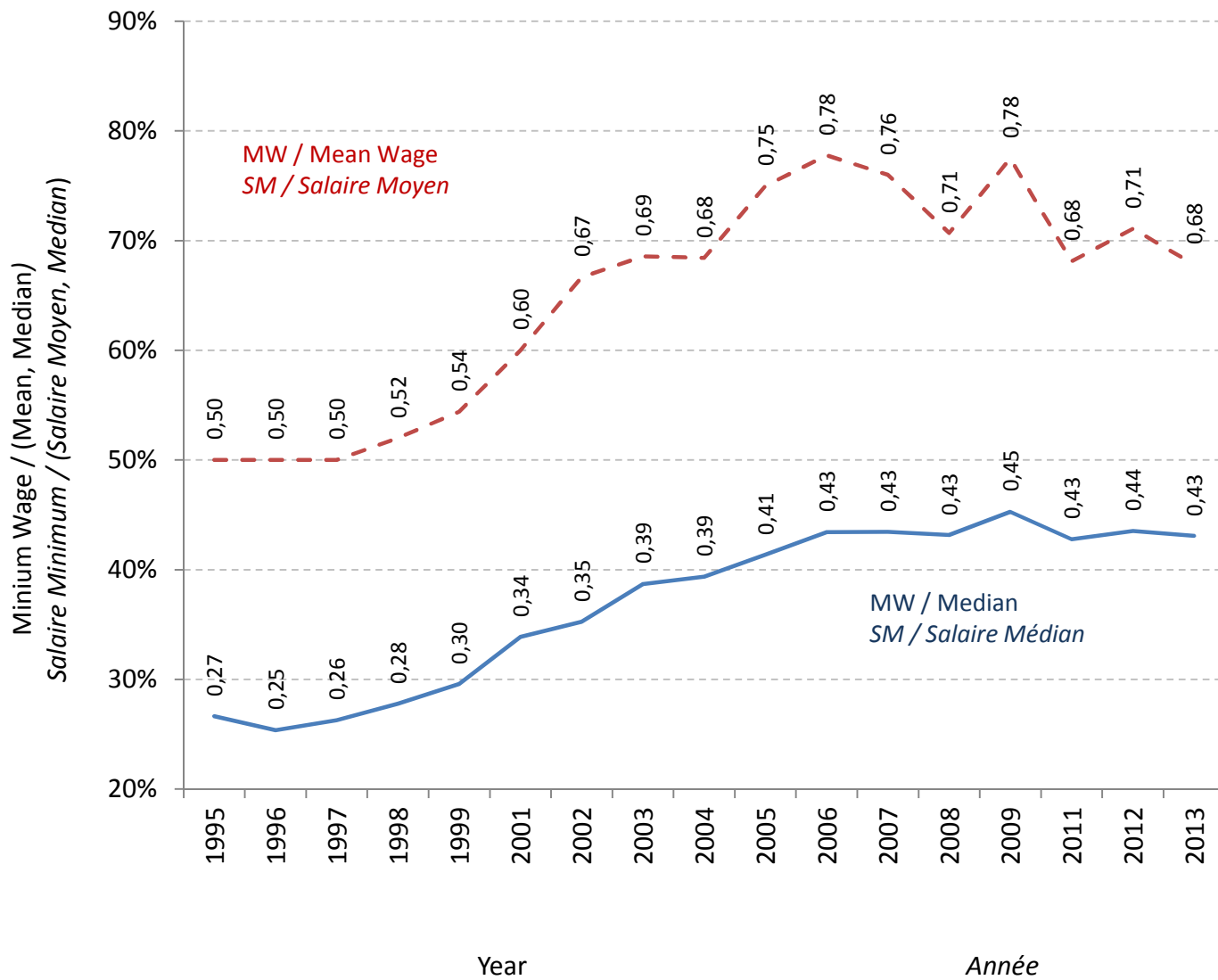

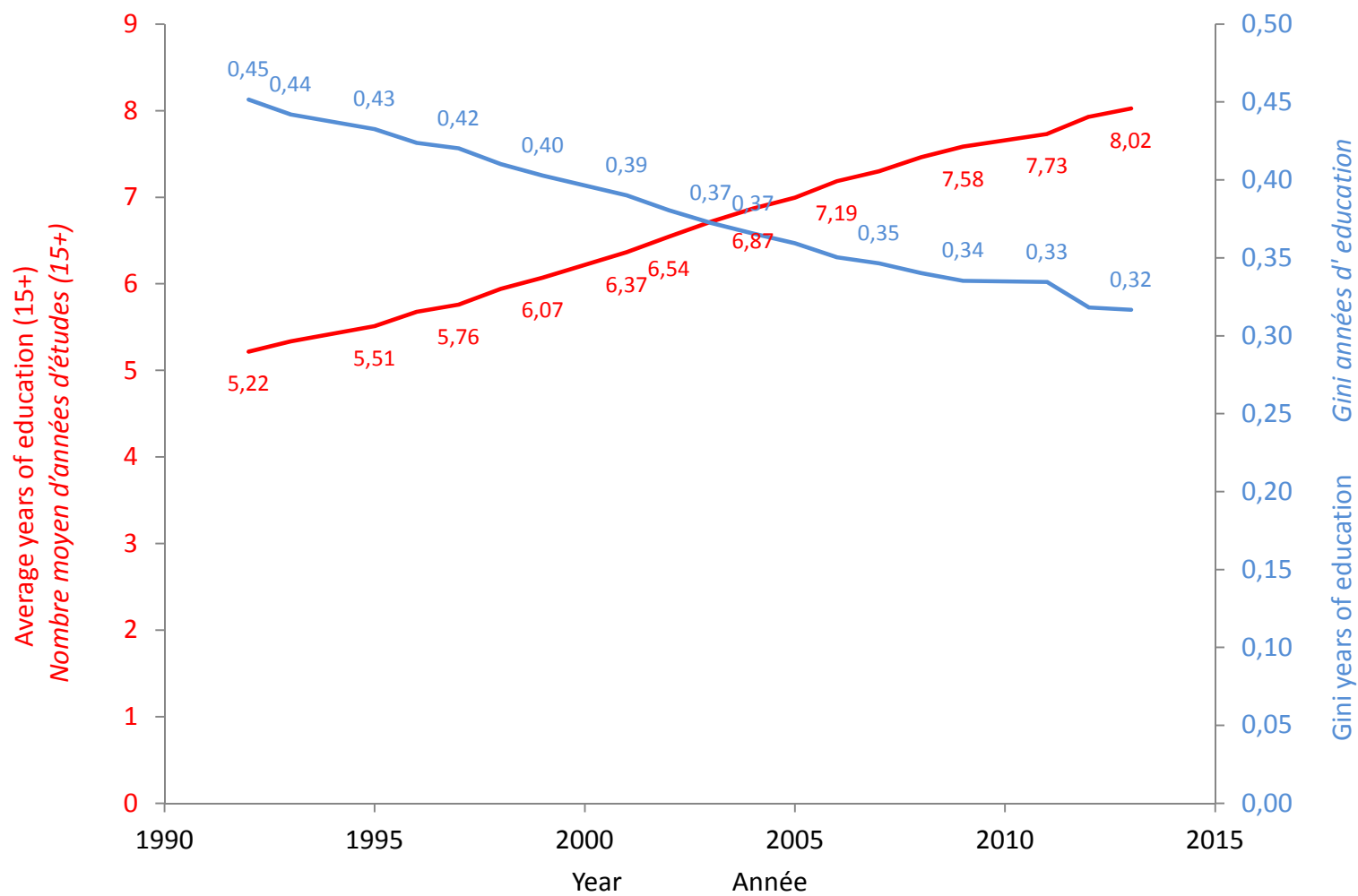

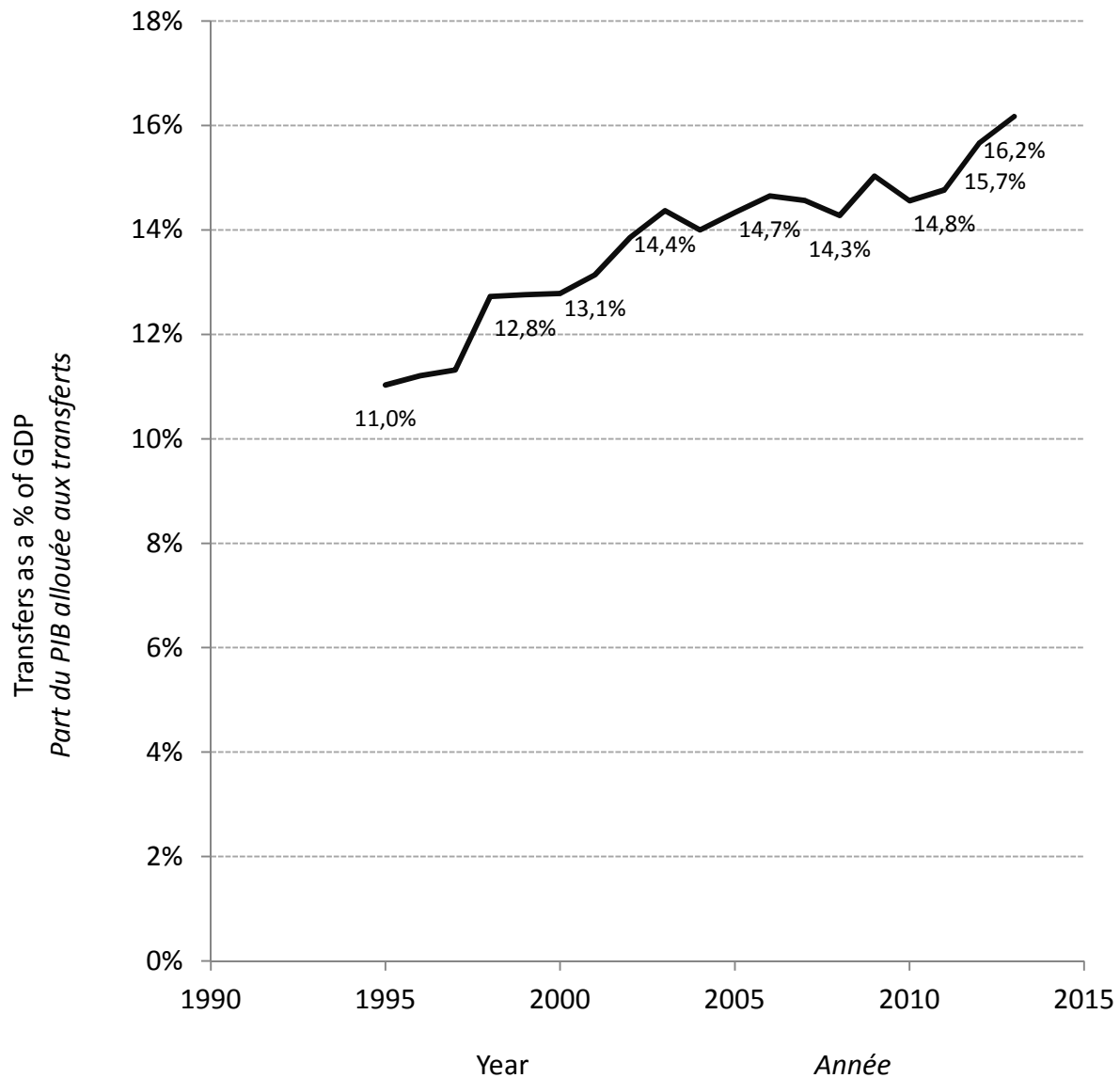

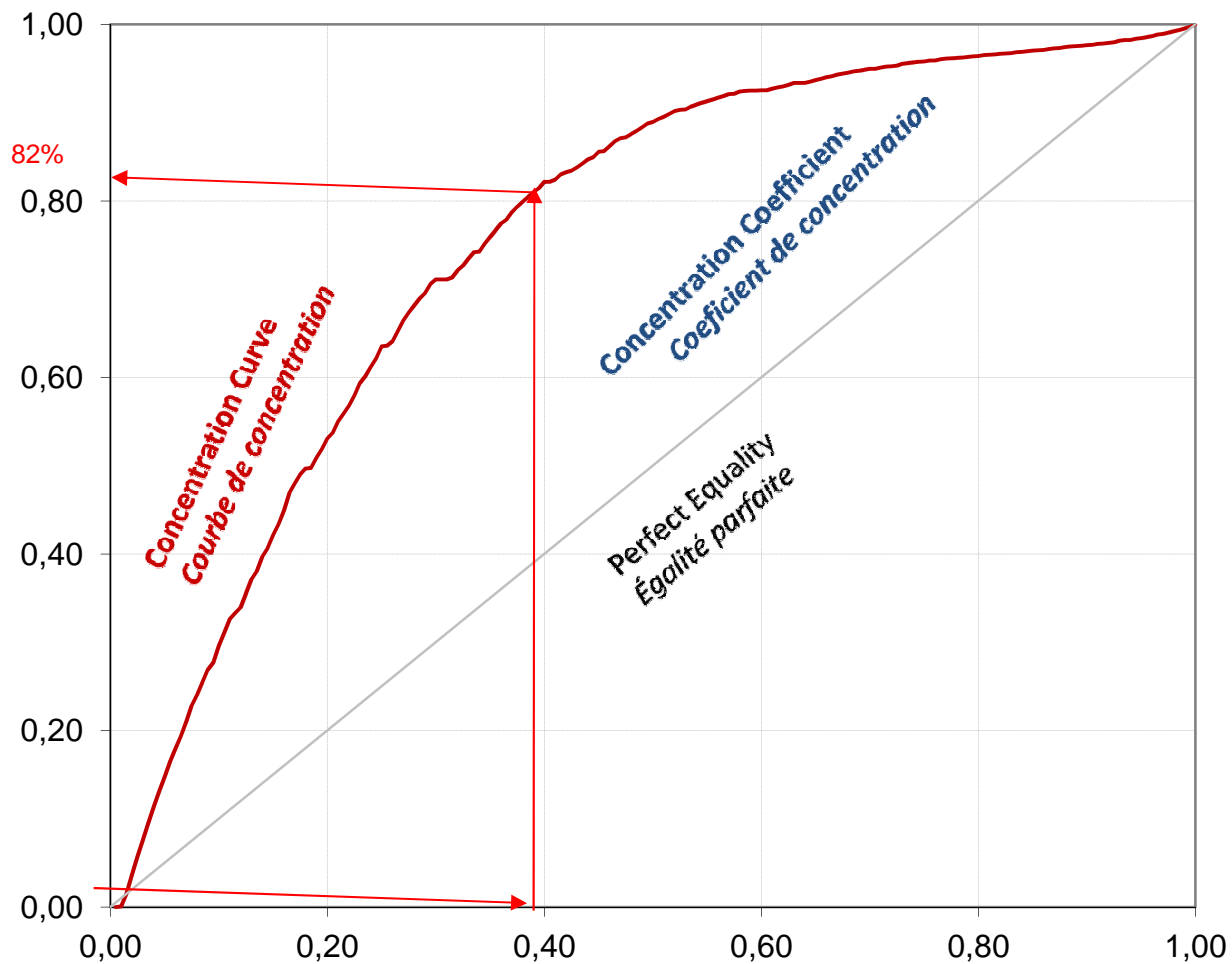
### Transfers as a percentage of GDP *Part du PIB allouée aux transferts*
